



Instructions for International Day of People with Disability (IDPwD) Paper Chains

1. Print out the paper chain PDF from the [IDPwD promotional products page](#) on the website. For best results, print in colour on A3 sized paper.
2. Print out as many as you like! One A3 sheet will make a chain approximately 50cm long, so make sure you print out enough.
3. Cut out each colourful strip, then cut the strips in half.
4. Take your half-strip, and join them together at the ends to make a small loop. You can use a stapler, a gluestick, or sticky tape – whatever works best for you!
5. Take another half-strip (maybe of a different colour) and thread it through your first loop. Join the ends together, and now you have the beginning of a chain.
6. Keep threading the half-strips through the loops until your paper chain is as long as you'd like.
7. You now have a paper chain to decorate your workplace, classroom, home, community or IDPwD event!
8. Take a photo of your paper chain and share it on social media. Make sure to use the hashtags #idpwd #includeme on Facebook, Twitter or Instagram to show how you celebrated IDPwD.
